Homicides.

1875. Ryan, Mathew, saloon keeper, 308 Archer Av., shot dead at that place, by James Finucan, street car conductor, who was arrested, 4th Prec.

1875. Ryder, Mary Ann, 18 years old, shot dead, 81 W. Washington St., by Andrew Johnson, who was arrested. The girl, who was a servant, was trying to repair a hydrant in the yard, was ordered to desist by Johnson, when a quarrel ensued, resulting as above.

1876. Rose, Frederick, died, home, 426 Archer Av. Shot Jan. 10, in saloon brawl, 1016 S. Halsted St., by Thomas Roney, ex-police officer, who was arrested. 22d St. Station.

1877. Raggio, David, notorious thief, died at his mother's home, 77 Stewart Av., as result of a pistol shot received Jan. 26, at Harrison and State Sts., by Mrs. Mitchell, whom he attempted to rob.

1877. Rusk, Benjamin, colored, 30 years old, killed front of No. 3 Marichion St., in quarrel over a woman, by Winfield Osborne, also colored, who struck Rusk with a slung shot. Osborne was arrested. W. Madison St. Station.

1877. Ryan, Miss Nellie, 21 years old, from Launce's Junction, Ill., died from abortion at 16th N. Sangamon St. Amelia Spork, midwife, 218 W. Indiana St., arrested. W. Madison St. Station. (279.)

1878. Race, Officer, Harrison St. Station, shot dead in front of Frei Berg's pawnshop, 474 State St., by Johnny Lamb, who was arrested and sentenced to hang. New trial granted and acquitted.

1880. Robinson, Lottie, keeper of house of ill fame, 75 W. Kinzie St., shot dead at that place by George W. Stratton, who was arrested and sent to Pen. (Central Detail.)

1882. Ryan, James, noted thief and thug, fatally shot, Wright and Morgan Sts., by Officer Daniel Pembroke, whom he and another thief, Owen McCarthy, assaulted. Officer Pembroke fired to save his life. W. 12th St. Station.

1883. Roskiter, Lawrence, 17 years old, shot dead by Anton Bauer in front of the latter's saloon, 1061 Milwaukee Av. Bauer was arrested. Rawson St. Station.

1883. Ryan, Thomas, & Dawdy, fatally shot (died) Pullman, by William Ray, boarding house keeper, who was arrested in company with George Fox (also shot) at above.

1886. Redden, Officer Thomas, W. Lake St. Station, fatally wounded, Haymarket riot. Died May 16.

1884. Roberts, Mattie, sold, fatally shot, Mattie Bell's house of ill fame, 2d Prec., by her husband, Edward Roberts, who had left her husband and on her refusal to return to him shot her.
